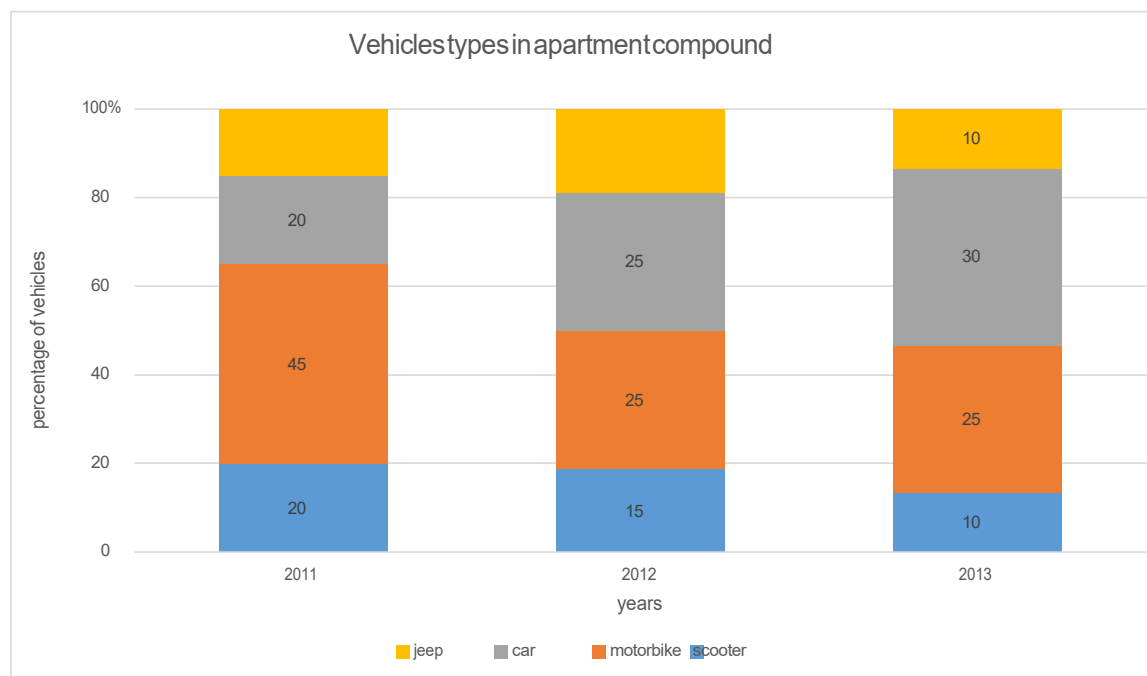

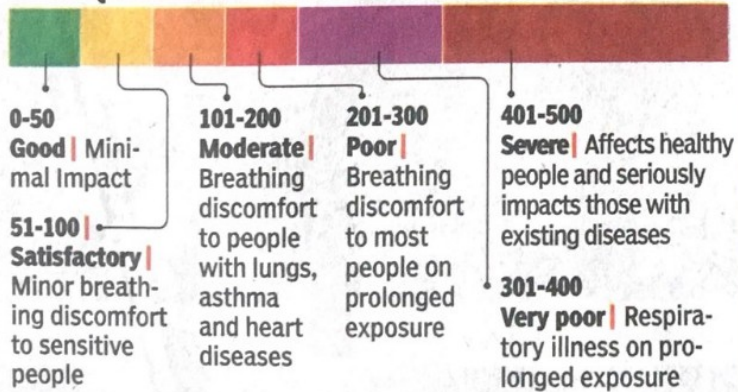

WHAT IS AQI

AQI is the numerical scale used to assess air quality, focussing on calculating the effects of the air to the health of people. It looks for major pollution causing factors in the air. They include particulate matter, ground-level ozone, sulfur dioxide, nitrogen dioxide, and carbon monoxide, among others

Module 5

Creative and critical thinking -Science (class VII)

Rusting: **Rust** is an [iron oxide](#), a usually red powdery substance formed by the reaction of [iron](#) and [oxygen](#) in the presence of [water](#) or air moisture. It is also called oxidation reaction as it takes place in the presence of oxygen. Presence of salty water enhances the process of rusting. To protect from being rusted, the iron metal can be treated in different ways. For example: oiling, painting or galvanization. Making alloys is another way to protect the metal from corrosion. Most of the metals reacts with air when exposed to it and form a coating on them.

Oxidation of metals is not always undesirable, for example aluminium. The coating of oxide on the surface of aluminium sheet is extremely hard and abrasion resistant preventing any further reaction with oxygen and it can be dyed to make it colored, making it an ideal material for mobile phones.

Take the term "Hindustan", for example. Today we understand it as "India", the modern *nation-state*. When the term was used in the thirteenth century by Minhaj-i-Siraj, a chronicler who wrote in Persian, he meant the areas of Punjab, Haryana and the lands between the Ganga and Yamuna. He used the term in a political sense for lands that were a part of the dominions of the Delhi Sultan. The areas included in this term shifted with the extent of the Sultanate but the term never included south India. By contrast, in the early sixteenth century Babur used Hindustan to describe the geography, the fauna and the culture of the inhabitants of the subcontinent. As we will see later in the chapter, this was somewhat similar to the way the fourteenth-century poet Amir Khusrau used the word "Hind". While the idea of a geographical and cultural entity like "India" did exist, the term "Hindustan" did not carry the political and national meanings which we associate with it today.

हाँफ़ती रही हुगली

सदियों से हुगली की गहरी और नीली धारा लोगों को अपनी नीलिमा के आकर्षण में बांधती, करोड़ों लोगों की प्यास बुझाती और उन्हें पालती-पोसती आ रही है किंतु आज खुद बेतरह प्रदूषित होकर हाँफ़ रही है। करीब पाँच सौ किलोमीटर की यात्रा तय करते हुए। गंगोत्री से गंगासागर तक गंगा करीब दो हजार नौ सौ किलोमीटर की लंबी यात्रा तय करती है। हुगली सागर में मिलती है पर इस सफ़र में उसे कोलकाता, हावड़ा समेत जगह-जगह विभिन्न नगरों, उपनगरों और कस्बों की गंदगी और कचरे को गले लगाना पड़ता है। इससे हुगली का दम घुटने लगा है। हर साल मिट्टी की बनी हज़ारों प्रतिमाओं के अलावा बारह हज़ार अधजले और 60 हज़ार मरे जीव-जंतु हुगली में विसर्जित किए जाते हैं। सात सौ से ज्यादा कल-कारखानों का कचरा और नालियों का 25 करोड़ गेलन गंदा पानी इस नदी को भेंट किया जाता है। हुगली की तलहटी कचरे से पटती जा रही है और इसकी जल ग्रहण क्षमता हर वर्ष घटती जा रही है।
